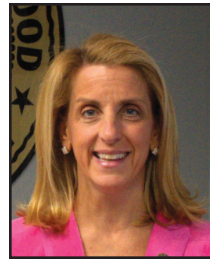

CURBSIDE BULK DAY ITEM LIMIT

*mandated by
Ordinance #3877*

Residents are limited to 7 items on curbside bulk day. Here are a few details that will help you stay in compliance and accurately count your items:

1. Each bag or barrel of trash counts as one item.
2. If you take something apart to get it to the curbside, it only counts as one item. (Please don't count each dismantled piece.)
3. Items that are recycled like metals, tires, auto batteries, stoves, refrigerators, etc. do not count against your limit. Please put them in a separate pile.

A great way to keep your item count low is by donating gently used items. Remember, your trash may be someone else's treasure! Note: Clothes, shoes, white rigid foam packaging, and e-waste should be brought to the Recycling Center.

See the Village website for specific overnight parking lots for other locations. Permits are issued for 3 months for \$85 or 6 months for \$170. Proof of residency is required.

The new Tree Permit Application as well as the recently adopted Village Tree Ordinance is available for pick up in the Engineering Division Office, located on Level 3 in the Village Hall. If the trees that you would like to remove are dead, diseased, dying or pose an immediate safety hazard, the permit fee is waived, but an application is still required to be submitted to the office. If you would like to remove a healthy tree from your property, the permit fee is \$50.00 per tree and a replacement tree is required, which may be planted on either your property or for a fee of \$500.00 at another location within the Village. SAFE DISPOSAL OF MEDICAL WASTE

To protect sanitation workers, syringes must be placed in sturdy, puncture resistant containers with screw-on caps (e.g. detergent or bleach bottles). Secure the cap, label the container “Do Not Recycle – Contains Sharps,” dispose of container in trash (not recycling). Never use coffee cans or glass bottles.

RECYCLING IS THE LAW

In 1987, Governor Kean signed the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act. This law makes recycling mandatory throughout the entire state of New Jersey in accordance with local recycling ordinances. Ridgewood Ordinance 2284 requires residents, institutions, schools, and businesses to separate and recycle newsprint, corrugated cardboard, mixed papers (magazines, catalogs, direct mail, white and colored office paper), tin/steel cans, aluminum cans, plastic bottles, glass bottles, major appliances, non-ferrous and ferrous metals, and vegetative waste. Failure to comply may result in a summons.

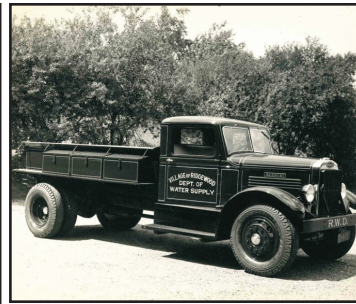

APPROVALS AND PERMITS NEEDED FOR REMOVAL OF TREES ON PRIVATE PROPERTY: *The Village of Ridgewood has regulations regarding the removal of trees on private property. A plan showing the trees for removal is submitted to the Engineering Division, in Village Hall, and a permit for tree removals must be obtained. An inspection by a licensed arborist to evaluate the condition of the trees, prior to removal is required. There are also requirements for obtaining an exemption, replacing the trees on your property is required, and paying a fee to a tree fund, which will be used by the Village for planting trees throughout Ridgewood.*

INSPECTION OF SMOKE DETECTORS: The State of New Jersey requires the installation and inspection of smoke detectors, carbon monoxide alarms, and a fire extinguisher, prior to the **Sale, Rental, Transfer or Lease** of one and two family dwelling units. To obtain a Certificate of Compliance, call the Fire Prevention Bureau at 201-444-7898 Ext. 5480 at least 3 weeks prior to change of tenant or house closing to set up an appointment in order not to delay receiving your certificate in a timely manner. FIRE PREVENTION MONTH COOK WITH CAUTION

- Cooking fires are the leading cause of home fires and injuries.
- Have a “kid-free zone” of at least 3 feet around the stove.
- Turn pot handles toward the back of the stove.
- Watch what you heat, and set a timer to remind you.

BATTERY RECYCLING

The Ridgewood Recycling Center accepts **ONLY** button cell batteries and dry-cell rechargeable batteries weighing up to 11 lbs. (and 300 Wh for Li-ion). Each individual battery must be packaged in an individual baggie or the terminal ends must be taped securely with non-conductive adhesive tape. Packaging guidelines are required by the U.S. Department of Transportation. Alkaline batteries are manufactured with no added mercury and can be disposed of in the regular trash.

LEAF SEASON

Ridgewood’s annual leaf pickup begins approximately the 3rd week of October. The Village is divided into 4 areas for leaf pickup, each with specific schedules. Refer to the schedule for your street. If you need to identify your “area” you can find it at www.ridgewoodnj.net - My Village Services Lookup. If there are any revisions to the scheduled pickups, we will use E-Notice and the Village website to alert residents to any changes. The leaf area map is located at the back of the calendar.

General Information

Ridgewood Water provides water service to Glen Rock, Midland Park, and Wyckoff in addition to the Village of Ridgewood. The primary water supply is from more than 50 deep wells located throughout the service area. Supplemental water is purchased from Veolia Water, the Borough of Hawthorne, and Passaic Valley Water Commission. All sources are tested regularly to ensure compliance with Federal and State water-quality standards.

Billing Information

Water meters are read remotely on a monthly schedule and accounts are billed quarterly. If you are selling your home or business, a final meter reading and final bill are required to close your account. To schedule a meter reading, please contact Customer Service at cswater@ridgewoodnj.net or 201-670-5520 at least 5 business days prior to the closing date.

Connections and Service Lines

To establish a new water service connection, disconnect an existing service, re-establish a disconnected service, or arrange short-term turn-off and turn-on service, please contact Customer Service at cswater@ridgewoodnj.net or 201-670-5520. Lead contamination can occur when stagnant water is in contact with plumbing materials containing lead for several hours. If you would like to know the material of your service line please refer to Ridgewood Water's website to utilize the service line lookup tool or call Customer Service at 201-670-5520. For further information regarding lead please visit our website at water.ridgewoodnj.net.

Water Quality Information

Detailed information on water quality is provided in our annual Consumer Confidence Report, available on our website. Additional copies are available at the office of Ridgewood Water.

Water Conservation Regulations

Water conservation regulations are in effect year round. Demand often exceeds the available water supply from wells and interconnections during hot and dry weather. For conservation purposes, Ordinance #3588 was adopted in April 2017 making two-day per week irrigation permanent with amendments adapted by Ordinance #3940 in April 2023.

- **Odd-numbered addresses are permitted to water on Tuesday and Saturday.**
- **Even-numbered addresses are permitted to water on Wednesday and Sunday.**
- **Irrigation is not permitted Monday, Thursday, or Friday.**
- **Water Emergency Stages 3 and 4 (if enacted) will change these irrigation regulations.**

Residents are encouraged to use smart controllers for all automatic irrigation systems (rain sensors are always required). Smart controllers incorporate real-time weather data to water only when needed. Properties using smart controllers can obtain a permit from Ridgewood Water to be exempt from two-day per week irrigation regulations (restrictions noted on permit application). Recycling Center

203 E. GLEN AVENUE

Recycling Collection Days – Areas (1-8)

Materials are divided into two categories and are picked up every other week at curbside.

• Containers:

Steel and aluminum cans, glass and plastic bottles and food/beverage cartons (e.g. milk, juice, soup) should be emptied, rinsed, and placed loosely (not bagged) in the official **Village recycling barrels only!**

PAPER:

For curbside pickup ONLY, newsprint, magazines, junk mail, newspaper inserts, mixed papers, brown paper bags and corrugated cardboard may be placed next to the Village recycling barrel for pickup. Papers should be contained in the blue and green recycling crates, in empty cardboard boxes, in paper bags or may be tied with twine in bundles not exceeding 12 inches in height.

Note: Papers brought to the recycling center must be separated into two groups. 1) Magazines, junk mail, newspaper, and mixed papers, and 2) Brown paper bags and corrugated cardboard.

Auto Batteries, Tires, Metals (doors, radiators, appliances)

Pickups on Wednesdays –

“Eastside” Areas 1, 3, 5, 7 or

“Westside” Areas 2, 4, 6, 8

- For collection schedules and disposal information please download the Recycle Coach mobile application.
- Use the Village recycling crates for newsprint and mixed papers only. Never use the recycling barrel for paper or cardboard.
- Cans and bottles must be loose (not bagged) and placed in the official beige Village recycling barrel only.
- Residents who move are required to leave the beige recycling barrel and recycling crates for use by the future occupants.

- All containers must be removed from curbside by midnight on the day of the collection. Recyclables must be placed at the curb after 5 pm the night prior to collection, or before 6 am on the day of the collection.
- Recycling containers are available for purchase at the Recycling Center.
- The routes and schedules are outlined in the Green Guide recycling flyer, which is mailed to each home annually.
- Service requests and questions regarding recycling may be directed to 201-670-3373 or 201-670-5500 x4266.

The **Recycling Center** is located at 203 East Glen Avenue. Hours: Monday through Saturday 8 am – 3 pm; (closed Wednesdays and Sundays). Please have materials properly separated, in the trunk of your vehicle, and follow instructions from our attendant.

Solid Waste Collection

Starts at 6 am

HOUSEHOLD REFUSE – Picked up in Rearyard:

West Side: Monday & Thursday – West side routes include all homes west of Maple Avenue and homes on Prospect Street and Maple Avenue

East Side: Tuesday & Friday – East side routes include all homes east of Maple Avenue on both sides of Route 17

NOTE FOR SOLID WASTE COLLECTION:

- Place refuse container(s) within 20 feet of the house at **ground level**, in the same location for each collection.
- Please use watertight metal or plastic containers with lids, not to exceed 32 gallons in capacity and 80 pounds in gross weight. Refuse collectors may not enter any structure, i.e., garages or utility sheds.
- Household refuse will not be collected from the beige Village recycling barrels.
- During holiday weeks, please check the calendar for proper collection days.
- Effective September 2, 2008 and mandated by Ordinance #3134, there is a **\$150 fee for an unscheduled curbside garbage pickup**. This fee must be paid in advance of the pickup. To **schedule call 201-670-5579**.

• **When snow and ice is forecast for a scheduled day of garbage pickup**, affected residents are to bring their garbage cans to the curb for collection. VOR staff will pick up garbage at the curb on snow days or ice conditions. A snow day is when snow has been falling and the driveway areas are covered. An ice condition is when ice is present on driveways and sidewalks. When snow has stopped, please remember to clear a path to your refuse containers.

BULK REFUSE – CURBSIDE: Bulk refuse is household solid waste that does not qualify for rearyard collection and is limited to 7 items per pickup. It includes items such as furniture, carpets and padding, and toys that cannot be recycled, but should not exceed 120 pounds. Bulk refuse is not collected during holiday weeks. Please check the calendar for your scheduled days. Please place all loose items in disposable containers such as plastic bags. The Village is not responsible for any non-disposable containers used on curbside days. All mattresses, regardless of fabrication or size, must be contained in plastic mattress disposal bags prior to curbside set out.

NOTE:

- Item Limit – 7 items maximum
- Bulk refuse should not exceed 120 pounds
- Maximum length of materials = 72 inches
- Latex (water-based) paint should be dried/hardened before placement at the curb for bulk refuse collection.
- Bulk refuse will not be collected from the beige Village recycling barrels.
- **THE VILLAGE WILL NOT PICK UP:** Materials over 120 pounds or tree stumps, firewood, dirt, rocks, concrete or electronic devices including TVs
- Service requests and questions regarding solid waste may be directed to 201-670-5579.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE:

- Household hazardous waste such as oil-based paint, fluorescent bulbs, thinners, insecticides, and antifreeze, should be saved and taken to a **Bergen County Household Hazardous Waste Disposal** event. For information, call the event hotline at **201-807-5825** or visit www.bcua.org.

DOG AND CAT LICENSING

- The Health Department regulates the licensing of all dogs and cats residing within the Village. Cat licenses must be renewed in January. Dog licenses must be renewed in June.
- Anyone applying for a dog or cat license must present a valid rabies certificate for the entire licensing period. New dogs and cats are required to be licensed within 10 days of acquisition or moving into Ridgewood. Call 201-670-5500 ext. 5503 for more information.
- No dog shall be permitted to run at large. All pet owners and keepers are required to immediately and properly dispose of their pet’s solid waste deposited on any property, public or private, not owned or possessed by that person.

Dog Rabies Clinic: Graydon Pool Parking Lot, Wed., May 6, 6 – 7 pm. All dogs must have a valid rabies certificate.

VITAL STATISTICS

- **Certificates of any birth, death, or marriage** that has occurred in the Village may be obtained at the Health Department. Birth certificates are \$25.00 for the first copy and \$20.00 for additional copies purchased on the same day, marriage certificates are \$20.00 per copy, death certificates are \$25.00 for the first copy and \$2.00 for additional copies purchased on the same day. Payment by cash,

check, money order or credit card.

• **Marriage and civil union licenses** are also issued by the Health Department to couples planning to be married in New Jersey. A license can be applied for in the municipality where either party lives. A witness, 18 years or older, must accompany the couple at the time of application; and a 72-hour waiting period from the time of application is required before a license can be issued. License fee is \$28.00. To make an appointment for a marriage license application, call 201-670-5500 ext. 2242.

• **The Ridgewood STIGMA-FREE Initiative** is a village-wide program that aims to reduce the stigma associated with mental illness. We are dedicated to raising awareness of the disease of mental illness and creating a culture where residents who have the disease feel supported by their community and neighbors and feel free to seek treatment without fear of stigma.

Yard Waste Collection

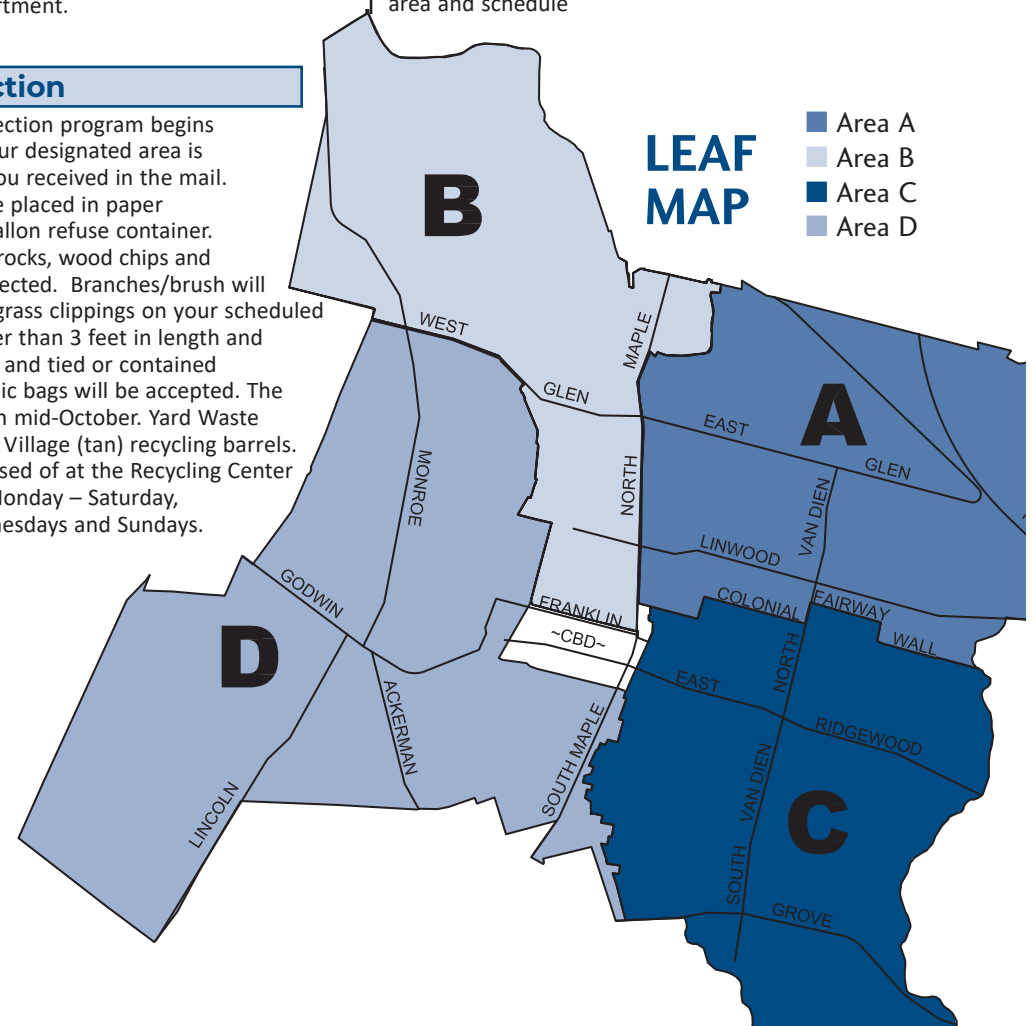
• The Village Yard Waste Collection program begins April 6th. The schedule for your designated area is contained in the Guide that you received in the mail. Grass clippings ONLY are to be placed in paper biodegradable bags or a 32-gallon refuse container. Yard Waste that includes dirt, rocks, wood chips and large root balls will not be collected. Branches/brush will be collected separately from grass clippings on your scheduled day. Branches can be no longer than 3 feet in length and 2 inches in diameter, bundled and tied or contained in a refuse container. No plastic bags will be accepted. The program will continue through mid-October. Yard Waste will not be collected from the Village (tan) recycling barrels. Yard Waste may also be disposed of at the Recycling Center located at 203 E. Glen Ave., Monday – Saturday, 8 am – 3 pm. Closed on Wednesdays and Sundays.

Leaf Season

• Beginning on October 13, and in accordance with your designated area, please place loose leaves in the street at the curb line, and bagged leaves on the curb. You will receive a Leaf Flyer mailed to your home prior to the start of Leaf Season with instructions. Branches, twigs, brush, grass, pumpkins, hay bales, corn stalks or any other Yard Waste will not be collected during Leaf Season. Only leaves will be collected during Leaf Season. You may bring branches/brush to the Recycling Center during normal business hours. No plastic bags or cans will be collected from the curb during leaf collection. The Village will not be responsible for any nondisposable containers placed out on scheduled pickup days. Do not park on dried leaves. It is a fire hazard. **Check www.ridgewoodnj.net for schedule updates and sign up for e-notice notifications to receive all updates. Snow and Ice (cleared within 24 hours)

Under local ordinance #2084, property owners are required to have sidewalks and paths cleared of snow and ice within 24 hours of a storm. *To avoid the frustration of having snow plowed back into a driveway, wait until the street is plowed before clearing a driveway entrance.* Snow and ice are removed from streets by the Village. **It is illegal for snow to be blown into the street. Residents can help by blowing snow from the walks onto the property side of the sidewalk, rather than into the street.** Please assist Fire Department by clearing the snow from the fire hydrant in front of your home. Additionally, please refrain from parking in the street when snow is in the forecast. In the Central Business District, snow is required to be removed by the responsible party, concurrently with its fall. Snowfalls starting after 6 pm are required to be cleared in their entirety no later than 9 am the following morning, Sundays and holidays included. Weekday storms, during business hours, are required to be cleared to a five-foot minimum width providing access from the storefront to the curb between meters. After 6 pm, the sidewalks are required to be completely cleared into the street.

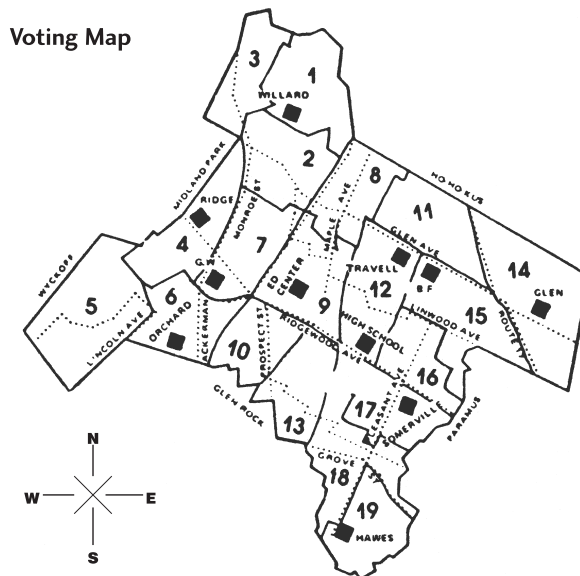

Did You Know?

❑ Permits are required from the Building Department for all **real estate signs**. Contractor signs are not permitted to be displayed in yards.

❑ **If you are a landscaper and want to discard leaves at the Lakeview facility** you may do so by purchasing tickets at the Reception Desk at Village Hall Monday-Friday 8:30 am to 4:30 pm. Residents are NOT permitted to dump at Lakeview.

❑ The Village requires a permit for **garage sales, yard sales**, etc. Permits are \$5.00 for two consecutive days and are limited to two sales per year. Applications available at Reception Desk at Village Hall.

❑ **Building permits are required for many types of residential projects** including: additions, alterations, sheds, pools, mechanical equipment, HVAC systems, fences, abandonment of fuel oil tanks, and demolition. A recent New Jersey Department of Community Affairs regulation eliminated construction permits for certain residential projects and it is recommended that before beginning any work to consult with the Building Department. The Building Department, located on the 3rd floor of Village Hall, is open Monday through Friday 8:30 am - 4:30 pm. If you prefer please call 201-670-5500 Ext. 5506.

❑ **Report missing street signs or broken parking kiosks/meters and Traffic Light Outages to the Traffic and Signal Division at 201-857-5126.**

❑ **Any excavation within the Village right-of-way requires a Street Opening Permit issued by the Engineering Division.** For everyone's safety, all excavations, both in the right-of-way and on private property, are required to call for a Utility Markout at 1-800-272-1000 or 811 on a cell phone before digging. Please call 201-670-5500 ext. 2238 to obtain a permit.

❑ The Village Code prohibits **improper storage of camping trailers, boats, automobiles**, etc.; restriction of corner visibility at street intersections; parking of vehicles on front lawns and commercial trucks not garaged.

❑ In emergency situations the Fire Department will pump out **flooded basements**. Call 911 for service.

❑ Summonses, water bills, and tax payments (checks only) may be placed in the yellow Village mail box located next to the parking lot entrance to Village Hall after hours. Please enclose payment in an envelope addressed to the appropriate department. We cannot be responsible for cash.
