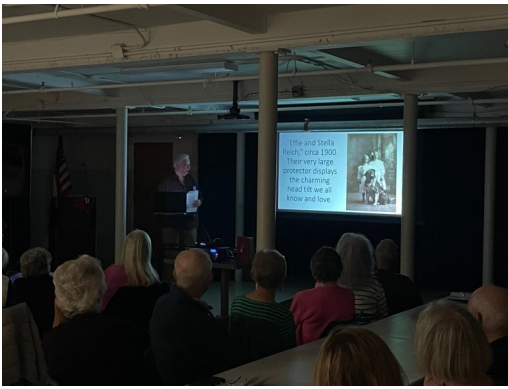

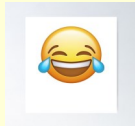
## **ON THE LIGHTER SIDE**
